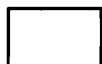
Dear Superintendent Arntzen:

On August 22, 2017, you had a telephone conference with the Ravalli County Commissioners. They asked you and your office to explain why you made it impossible for Literacy Bitterroot to apply for funds for Adult Basic Education services and you made several promises. You assured the Commissioners and the Literacy Board members that your office would be responsible for making sure that Missoula provided all the services in the Bitterroot that our local program had provided. When the Commissioners asked how you would be measuring the success of the Missoula efforts in the Bitterroot, you stated that the monitoring document would be available in March, and that it would be provided to our community so we could see what was required of Missoula. You also promised that you would make a copy of the completed monitoring document available to our community, and if Missoula was not successful, you would reopen the RFP for ABE services to MACO District XI.

It is now mid-April and we are seeking a copy of the monitoring document, as promised.
