Commissioners:

I have been a Hamilton resident for 40 years. I am opposed to the county tearing down the historic Dowling Funeral Home (formerly the BR Stock Farm offices). The city has a jewel of a property surrounding the historic home. There is no other property like this in Hamilton.

Several options you might consider are:

1. Relocate the museum to the historic home, thus saving the home and beautiful property surrounding it. Relocate the Justice Court to the museum, so it remains on the same block as the main courthouse.
2. Flip the offices of Justice Court #1 and the nurse's facility and re-route the inmates for a more direct route to appear in Justice Court.
3. Have the Courts use Vision Net for all initial appearances of inmates, as many courts in Missoula already use this tool.
