Ravalli County Airport is authorized, MTR000399, by the Montana Department of Environmental Quality to discharge under the MSGP at the discharge location (Outfalls) listed below.

Please read the General Permit to ensure you understand how to comply with the conditions. Keep a copy of this authorization letter, the facility's Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), and a copy of the 2018-issued MSGP on site at all times. Coverage under the MSGP remains in effect until the expiration on **January 31, 2023**, or the owner/operator submits a Notice of Termination (NOT). Annual fees continue to accrue until DEQ receives a NOT and annual fees are invoiced to the owner/operator in arrears. DEQ no longer provides or accepts paper Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs). Permittees must submit DMRs electronically via NetDMR.
