Good evening,

Week ten of the 66th Legislative Session has almost come to a close, with the Legislature holding its first Saturday hearings at tomorrow (March 16th) 9 a.m. Next week brings the last day for committees to request revenue bills, bills proposing referenda, and bills implementing HB 2 (March 19th) as well as the deadline for the transmittal of the revenue-estimating joint resolution and the last day to request study resolutions (March 23rd). The budget bill (HB 2) completed its hearings in the House Appropriations Committee this last week, so also coming next week is Second Reading for HB 2 on the House Floor on Monday at 1 p.m. and all day Tuesday (March 18th-19th).

To help keep you apprised of what's happening on the hill, we will continue to release a new issue of the MACo Legislative Update weekly until Sine Die.

This week's issue features the session calendar, as well as the bill hearings scheduled thus far for March 16th – 22nd, and the schedule is highlighted with MACo's priorities.
