ADA Sidewalks

ADA upgrades continue on Main Street in Stevensville this week with crews working to pour new sidewalks behind updated curbs. The following curbs have been made more accessible with flatter gentler slopes:

- Valley View SW and NW
- Barbara Street SW and NW
- South Ave SW and NW
- Ravalli St SW
- East side central avenue crosswalk
- West end of 6th street crosswalk

The public is asked to prepare for daytime noise, minor pedestrian detours, and some parking disturbances downtown. Please exercise caution when traveling through the work zone and watch carefully for crews and equipment.

ADA improvements are expected to be complete by the end of June, weather permitting.

Stevensville Pavement Preservation Update

Milling and paving activity in the Stevensville area is not expected to begin until mid-July; however, the schedule is extremely dynamic.
