Subject: Mill Creek Rd Speed Limit

Dear Commissioners;

I am disabled to the point where it would be impossible for me to attend your meeting on 7/11/19.

I believe it would be in the best interests and safety of the residents located on Mill Creek Rd, their children, wildlife, and all of those using this road to post a speed limit.

Prior to it's being paved several years ago, the speed limit on Orchard Drive was posted at 35 MPH. In that Orchard Drive is considerably wider than Mill Creek Rd, I would suggest posting a speed limit of 30 MPH.

Certainly not over 35 MPH.

In addition to the safety involved, especially with the fairly deep irrigation ditches on either side of Mill Creek Rd, the pot-holes and general maintenance of the road would be greatly improved, and certainly cost effective for the county.

Were I to be asked, I would recommend a total of 4 signs. One at the beginning of both the East and Westbound directions.

The other two near the intersection of Mill Creek Rd and Rummel Lane, both East and Westbound.

Thank you for your consideration of posting a sensible speed limit.
