Subject: Milling and Paving Begins on Lost Trail Pass TOMORROW

As you know, the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is undertaking a project near Lost Trial Pass this summer to extend the life of the roadway through pavement preservation. The Lost Trail Improvements project begins at the Idaho border and extends north along US 93 for 8.9 miles.

Work will begin this week with Milling starting on Tuesday, July 9 and Paving starting Thursday, July 10. Paving and Milling is expected to be complete by the end of July, with chip sealing happening in August.

We believe that we will be able to maintain two open lanes of traffic for most of the 8.9 mile stretch, with the exception being between Mile Marker 4.5 and Mile Mark 6.3, where drivers should expect single-lane driving with pilot cars and flaggers to direct traffic.
