1. Exhibits are due Monday of Fair week, between 3pm and 7pm, at the Floral Building
2. Exhibits will be judged Tuesday of Fair week, starting at 10am.
3. Container-grown plants and vases (if labeled) may be picked up Sunday after the Fair, between 12pm and 4pm, at the Floral Building

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

1. More than one exhibit per lot may be entered if each is a different genus, species, color, or variety/cultivar.
2. Cut specimens must:
 - a. have been grown by Exhibitor
 - b. include foliage (unless otherwise stated), but not below the water line
 - c. be displayed in a clear/colorless container and may be wedged with rocks/marbles
 - d. not exceed 30" from tip to cut end
 - e. be identified by genus/species name (if not printed on entry tag) and variety/cultivar name (if known)
 - f. be the color specified for that lot (if not specified, exhibit may be any color, but if multiple blooms, stems, etc. are required, they must all be the same color unless otherwise indicated)
3. Container-grown plants must:
 - a. have been grown by Exhibitor for at least 90 days (except for multiple plantings, which must have been grown by Exhibitor at least 6 weeks)
 - b. be named
 - c. not be poisonous to the touch

3. Exhibits may be picked up Sunday after Fair, between 12pm and 4pm.
4. General Guidelines:
 - a. Only one exhibit may be entered per class.
 - b. Every exhibit must contain some plant material. Fresh plant material should be refreshed if necessary by designer during Fair.
 - c. **Fresh** plant material **may not** be treated (e.g., painted, glittered, etc.) Dried plant material may be treated.
 - d. Unless otherwise indicated, exhibits **must not** contain:
 - artificial plant material (e.g., silk)
 - noxious weeds (see www.mtweed.org/identification)
 - landscapes or scenes
 - living members of the Animal Kingdom

- religious symbols or flags unless used respectfully and according to recognized etiquette

ALL DESIGNS MAY USE FRESH AND/OR DRIED PLANT MATERIAL

Division A: “Fire”

Champion/Reserve Champion Rosette - if merited (also see Special Premiums)

Class 01. “From Darkness to Light”

This *hanging design* will be displayed hanging from the arm of a post. Size: no more than 20” in length.

Class 02. “Distant and Glowing”

This *miniature design* will be displayed on a small white pedestal, provided by the fair. Size: no more than 5” in height, width, and depth.

Class 03. “It’s Hot”

This *exhibition table design* will be displayed on and/or in front of a background panel, provided by the exhibitor, on top of a table, provided by the fair. Size: must fit within a space 3’ wide and 2’ deep.

Division B: “Earth”

Champion/Reserve Champion Rosette - if merited

Class 01. “Alive & Awake”

This *tray table design* will be displayed on a tray provided by the exhibitor. The tray must include a menu, a table setting for one, and a floral design proportional to the tray. Size: must fit within a space 20” wide and 16” deep.

Class 02. “It’s Mostly Green”

This *miniature hanging design* will be displayed hanging in a 10” black hoop, provided by the fair. Size: no more than 7” in height, width, and depth.

Class 03. “Solid & Geometric”

This *large, free-standing design* will be displayed on the floor. The container the design is in must rest on the floor, i.e., the container cannot be elevated by a base or pedestal. Size: must fit within 3 square feet of floor space and should be no more than 5’ in height.

Division C: “Water”

Champion/Reserve Champion Rosette - if merited (also see Special Premiums)

Class 01. “Clean & Preserved”

This *table centerpiece design* will be displayed on a small table, provided by the fair. Size: no more than 18” in height, width, and depth.

Hint: add a table covering that coordinates with your design!

Class 02. “Fluid & Wet”

This *miniature design* will be displayed on a small white pedestal, provided by the fair. Size: no more than 5” in height, width, and depth. *Hint: use a container that isn’t more than a third of the overall height of your design!*

Class 03. “Every Drop Counts”

This *hanging design* will be displayed hanging on the front of a door, provided by the fair. Size: no more than 18” wide; no height restriction. *Hint: make your design proportional to the size of the door, which is 7’ tall and 2’ wide!*

Division D: “Air” - Youth (under 12 years of age)

Champion/Reserve Champion Rosette - if merited (also see Special Premiums)

Class 01. “It’s Free & Necessary”

This design will be displayed on a table provided by the fair. Size: must fit within a space 20” long and 14” deep.

Division E: “Metal” - Residents of a Long-Term Care Facility (exhibitors in this division may use artificial plant material)

Class 01. “Reflection of Time”

This design incorporating a basket will be displayed on a table, provided by the fair. Size: must fit within a space 20” long and 14” deep.
