4-H/FFA Small Animal Auction

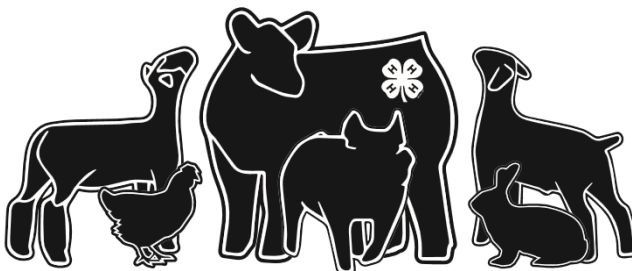

What can I do?

Come to the auction! Register early or on auction day to get your bidder number.

Buy an animal for your freezer!

If you need some meat, come to the auction and purchase an animal! You'll just need to know where you want to have it processed.

Purchase an animal for support!

If you want to buy at the auction but you don't need the meat - you can send it to support. You pay the difference between the market price and the bid, but you don't get the animal.

Give an add-on...or ten!

Want to support a specific 4-Her, multiple kids, or just want to donate? Call the Sale Administrator (Shawna Medlar at 360-2176) or talk to a clerk on auction day to discuss your options. You can add-on or donate to help with the overall sale expenses. How much you want to spend is really up to you.
